Take pictures of yourself being a 'superkid' at home. Maybe you tidied your room or helped wash the dishes? Bring in pictures to school to explain to your classmates what you did and how it helped your family.	Make a model of a superhero. You could use modelling dough, cardboard boxes and tubes, scraps of material or paper-mache.	
Read a story book or comic book about a superhero. Don't forget to record it in your reading diary.	Use information books and the web to find out about Guinness World Record holders and their superhuman achievements.	Listen and hum along to the theme tune from your favourite superhero TV programme. Can you remember all of the words and perform to the class?
If you could have a superpower, what would it be? Would you be able to fly? Become invisible? See-through buildings? Write about some of the adventures you might have.	Make up a song or rhyme about a superhero. You could sing about their strengths and skills.	Read a newspaper with a parent or watch the news and see if you can spot and stories of people doing heroic things.
