Our science focus this half term is plants.



Think about what you already know about Plants.

Go on a **plant hunt** around your garden or on your daily walk. What plants can you find? Do you know the names of any plants? What questions would you like to know about plants? Write these down and see if you can find out the answers during this half term.

Have fun looking at tiny plants and huge trees!

<u>Activity I</u>

Take a look at the Powerpoint in files called 'looking at plants' and show the children pictures of common wild garden plants and trees. Invite children to identify the plants if they can before revealing the names.

Activity 2

Try making a model of a flowering plant – can you label the parts flower, stem, leaves, roots? You could draw your flower or you could make one.



Activity 3

Children can complete the Flower and Plant Observation Sheet in files (or straight onto paper/exercise book) by drawing a labelled diagram of a plant and write a description. Or maybe try the tree observation sheet activity.

SPOILER ALERT! Next week we will be planting seeds and beginning a diary to record their growth. I will be using sunflower seeds but any seeds will do! If you can't get your hands on any, I will post pictures each week and there are lots of videos/clips that we can use.
