here is everything you need to inspire some fabulous descriptive writing this week. I found this Octopus text really interesting! I hope you do too!

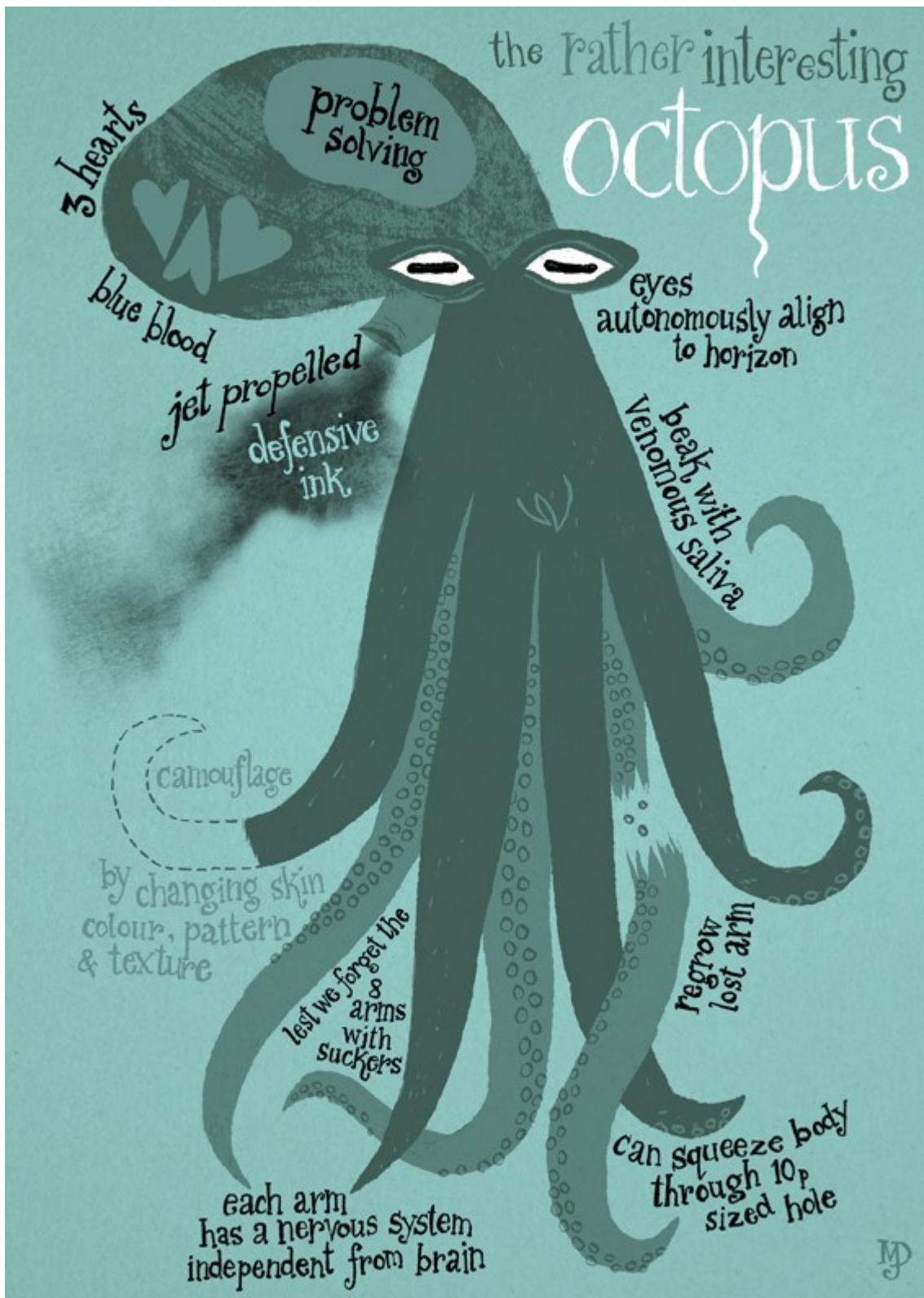
- Take your time.
