

How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth

Listen to 'How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth' being read on the Year 3 class page – discuss the book with someone at home and focus on how the book is a set of instructions!

Verbally instruct someone at home to complete the following tasks:

How to put on a pair of shoes

How to make a bed

How to get ready for school

What things were important to remember when instructing your friend or family member?

Watch the video of 'How to Wash a Woolly Mammoth' again. This time you are looking for imperative (bossy) verbs such as 'mix,' 'pour,' or 'add.' List all of the imperative verbs you find, then complete the worksheet – write a sentence using an imperative verb for each image, e.g. 'Scrub the woolly mammoth until sparkling.'

Look at the examples of the instructions, identifying the types of language used, the layout, who the audience is, and what punctuation you can see.
