

Enjoy books and love reading

Year 1 pupils are expected to read at least 3 times a week and have it recorded in individual reading diaries. (This could be a school book, a book at home, magazine or comic). Children will be given a stamp in their books and will achieve prizes for reading at home.

Quicken mental maths skills

Children should practise number bonds to 10 (the two digits that add up to 10) and know that $9+1 = 10$ so $1+9 = 10$. Familiarise your child with 2 and 5 timetables.

Please choose from the activities below. Aim to spend around 30 minutes on homework each week. Some activities will take longer than others and please feel free to take time to complete one activity over a series of weeks.

<p>Literacy: Keep practising phonics. Imagine you visited a circus and write a diary entry about your day or maybe you were the circus performer.</p>	<p>Maths: A juggler can juggle 10 balls but he only has 6, how many more does he need? What if he had 4 balls? Can you create your own juggler number problem?</p>	<p>Science: Can you bake circus themed biscuits or perhaps clown cupcakes? Take photographs or draw a picture to show the class.</p>
<p>History: Use information books and the internet to find out about the history of the circus? Can you list 3 similarities and differences between modern circuses and those from years ago?</p>	<p>Autumn Topic This is Me!</p> 	<p>Geography: How do you get to school every morning? Can you draw a map showing your route from home to school and label it?</p>
<p>Music: Have a movie night and watch <i>The Greatest Showman</i>. What is your favourite song and performer?</p>	<p>PE: Learn to juggle, ride a bike or practice walking on stilts or even walk a tightrope.</p>	<p>Art: Make a model of a clown. You could use modelling dough, cardboard boxes and tubes, scraps of material or papier-mâché.</p>
