Reading

Spellings and Times tables

Autumn 1 'Here We Are' Topic

Look at a maps, atlas or globe. What can you see?

Find the UK—where is it in the world?

Can you find Scotland, England, Wales and Ireland?

What cities do you find there?

Think about the geographical features of Shropshire e.g. River Severn, Wrekin

- Create a picture scrapbook of places you would like to visit.
- Draw what makes Shropshire beautiful.
- Create maps of journeys you might take (real or imaginary)
- Go out on a walk and familiarise yourself with the 8 compass points.
- Support your child by helping them learn the song
'What a Wonderful World' by Louis Armstrong.

Try writing new lyrics to fit this song.

This homework is optional so you can do as little or as much as you like and there is no deadline so you can do pieces throughout the half term. Please share photographs of any home learning via email or Class Dojo.
