- Use outdoor area to develop gross motor skills
- Explore climbing frame and the rules to use it safely
- Mix and pour in mud kitchen
- PE lessons—follow adult instructions
- Move in a variety of ways

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- Talk about feelings.
- Develop friendships with children.
- Express a range of emotions.
- Exploring new areas
- Notice and ask questions about differences.

Communication and Language

- Listen to others talk with interest.
- Start to say how they are feeling.
- Use mirrors to look at and identify their feelings
- Identify familiar objects (pictures from home).
- Begin to think about turn taking

- Enjoy taking part in action songs like the wheels on the bus and will join in.

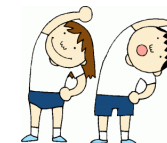
